Quick User Guide

Extra handset only for Care920-1

CONNECTING YOUR PHONE

Connect plug in corresponding socket in the charger. Insert power plug in an electrical outlet. Insert batteries in handset.

Before you start to use your telephone, charge batteries continuously for **15 hours**. Only use plug adaptor supplied with the unit and rechargeable battery pack with your phone.

REGISTRATION (Max. 3 handsets can be registered to the same base unit)

- 1 Make sure the handset is out of the charger and shows Register before you begin registration.
- Oricom Care920 Base: In idle mode, press and hold button under Page on display for around 5 seconds until Registration appears on display. Red

LED bar flashes at bottom.

- 3 On Handset Press OK/Menu key, scroll down to HS Setting. Press OK/Menu key, scroll down to Registration and press OK/Menu key. Handset display shows Registration and RED light on top flashes.
- 4 The handset displays **Registered**. It takes max. 90 seconds to complete the registration process. (X represents the registered handset number assigned automatically).
- When registration completes, the telephone base will emit confirmation beep, and Red LED light on either base will be off.

If registration fails, the handset displays **Impossible**, and then returns to the Idle screen.

Pls. repeat the above procedure.

TROUBLESHOOTING

As a general rule, if a problem occurs, remove the batteries from all handsets for about 1 minute, then disconnect and reconnect the power supply to the base and reinstall the handset batteries. For more information, get online assistance on www.oricom.com.au.

SAFETY

This telephone is not designed for Emergency Calls when the main power fails.

Do not use your telephone to notify a gas leak or other potential explosion hazard. Do not open your device or its power supply to avoid risk of electrical shock. Do not attempt to open the batteries, as they contain hazardous chemical substances.

Your telephone must be located in a

Express Warranty (Australia)

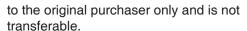
This Express Warranty is provided by Oricom International Pty Ltd ABN 46 086 116 369, Unit 1, 4 Sovereign Place, South Windsor NSW 2756, herein after referred to as "Oricom".

Oricom warrants that the product is free from defects in materials or workmanship during the Express Warranty Period. This Express Warranty does not extend to any product from which the serial number has been removed or was purchased outside of Australia.

The benefits of this Express Warranty are in addition to other rights and remedies you may have under the Australian Consumer Law. Our goods come with guarantees that cannot be excluded under the Australian Consumer Law. You are entitled to a replacement or refund for a major failure and compensation for any other reasonably foreseeable loss or damage. You are also entitled to have the goods repaired or replaced if the goods fail to be of acceptable quality and the failure does not amount to a major failure. In the event of a minor failure, Oricom reserves the right to choose to repair or replace the product.

The Express Warranty Period will be a period of 12 months beginning on the date of purchase of the product evidenced by your dated sales receipt. You are required to provide proof of purchase as a condition of receiving Express Warranty services.

You are entitled to a replacement product or repair of the product at our discretion according to the terms and conditions of this document if your product is found to be faulty within the Express Warranty Period. This Express Warranty extends

- A completed Return Authorisation form
- A copy of your Proof of Purchase (please keep your original copy)
- The faulty product, including all accessories.
